Why do you need to register with the Healthcare Commission?

- You are required by Law to do so.

What is the Healthcare Commission?

- They are a body set up by the government to assess all health care in England.

What does the process involve?

- Throughout the registration process you will be assessed against regulations and standards. Each facility must have a named responsible person who has been assessed as 'fit' to offer the service by the Healthcare Commission; they will also assess the 'fitness' of premises and services

How much does it cost?

- The exact fees are currently published by the Healthcare Commission on their website: www.healthcarecommission.org.uk
- A non refundable registration fee is payable when you submit your application
- When the service is assessed as fit and if you are granted registration, a further fee is payable and due annually thereafter on that date.
- You will also need to budget for the cost of equipment, training, service contracts etc.

How do I meet the standards for registration?

- Your facility must provide evidence to show that you comply with the CSA 2000 and its supporting regulations and Standards. Comprehensive policies, procedures and protocols are necessary.

Do I need outside help?

- If you are using lasers and or Intense Pulsed Light (IPL) you need to have the services of a certificated Laser Protection Advisor
- If you are not expertly medically qualified in the specific services you are offering you need Expert Medical Practitioner Protocols for treatments.

Do I need any training?

- You will need to demonstrate that you and your staff are appropriately trained for your service needs and that this training covers all the topics required within the National Standards.
